Dauphine-PSL invites applications for a vacant Assistant Professorship in critical management studies in DRM MOST (Markets, Organisations, Society and Technologies), one of the Organizational research teams of DRM.

The MOST team comprises a group of researchers specialised in different fields of management around a project based on the critical analysis of the managerialisation and merchandisation of society. Its aim is to develop and promote research focused on the relationships between the ways organisations are governed and the markets and managerial technologies deployed to this end. It also aims to identify and propose alternative forms of design, coordination and testing of organised initiatives.

The MOST team researchers conduct work within a range of epistemological paradigms and methodological systems. However, they favour a cross-disciplinary approach and one that places management sciences within the field of social sciences. In announcing an assistant professorship in critical management studies, the department wishes to strengthen its areas of interest: 1) Critical perspectives on Corporate Social Responsibility and Sustainable development; 2) Historical perspectives on accounting and management control 3) Critical perspectives on social construction of markets.
